The regular rates of the chosen plan by SFU will apply.

A10: Yes. We will provide to your school an administration fee of 5% on all sales to SFU 's students. This sum can be used by SFU to defray administrative costs, to fund student scholarships, to improve your existing technology, or to address other needs within your organization.
